Air Force Bomb Tech Veteran to Get Goodman Indoor Comfort Facelift

HOUSTON, August 29, 2018 – Matt Moyers faces the challenges of multiple wounds from years of service as an U.S. Air Force veteran and bomb technician, but soon his home will be more comfortable, after Goodman Manufacturing Company, L.P. donates and a local dealer installs a new high-efficiency heating and cooling system.
